A formal resolution appointing Ms. Hamilton will be offered at the September Council meeting.

Shared Services - Contracts

In regard to protocol at the Regular Meeting which had been moved to the Bogert School, Mayor Minichetti will enforce a 3 minute speaking limit and a 10 PM deadline and will caution the speakers from making statements that may be discriminatory. It was agreed that Mr. Regan and Mr. Rosen will respond to all answers regarding the eruvs.
