Jonathan,

As the Chairman of the Town Council Ordinance Committee, I wanted to make you aware of a grow concern in our community. Several residents have expressed concern and aggravation concerning inappropriate use of our local parks. They have reported numerous circumstances where large gro or parties have used our open spaces inappropriately and left them in poor condition. Our DPW grc then tasked to clean up the area, using labor hours that can be better utilized elsewhere in the township.
