WHEREAS, the Board of Adjustment of the Township of Teaneck has, by Resolution duly adopted on April 14, 1969, recommended to the Township Council that a variance be granted to Congregation Bnai Yeshrun to use the existing building for religious purposes, which does not comply with the requirements of the R-A One Family Residence Zone; R-A Zone, premises 655 West Englewood Avenue, Block 120, Lots 11/12, with one condition; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution of the Board of Adjustment does fully set forth a summarization of the evidence presented at a hearing held before the Board, and does make comprehensive findings and conclusions for the recommendation of said variance; and

WHEREAS, the Council has had the benefit of the comprehensive Minutes of the Board of Adjustment of said hearing and has thoroughly familiarized itself with the facts and circumstances surrounding said application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Teaneck that the variance with condition as recommended by the Teaneck Board of Adjustment, be granted to Congregation Bnai Yeshrun, 655 West Englewood Avenue, Block 120, Lots 11/12, in the Township of Teaneck.
